Persons authorized to provide public testimony shall not use vulgar, abusive, or otherwise inappropriate language when addressing the Board; failure to act appropriately; failure to speak to an item that is germane to the meeting, or failure to adhere to the time requirements may result in expulsion from the meeting and/or disqualify the person from providing future testimony.

PROPOSED BID RECOMMENDATION

Department: Planning and Development

Request: Authorization for the Forest Preserves District of Cook County (the "Preserves") to enter into a contract with Matthew Paving, Inc., Chicago, Illinois for various trail crossings improvements on the Salt Creek Bicycle Trail, North Branch Bicycle Trail, and Tinley Creek Bicycle Trail.

Reason: Contract 13-80-02-14C1, Trail Crossings Improvements. The work includes, but is not limited to, various trail crossings improvements at three highest priority crossings at Glenview Road and Harms Road on the North Branch Bicycle Trail, and at 31st Street & Edgewood Ave and LaGrange Road & Cermak Road on the Salt Creek Bicycle Trail, as well as signage and pavement markings improvements on the Tinley Creek Bicycle Trail. Improvements include the realignment of the 10' wide bicycle trail at various intersections, traffic signal modifications, updating bicycle and pedestrian signing and advanced signing, updating pavement markings and other related work as specified in the plans & specifications.
