FOREST PRESERVE FEE SCHEDULE

Amending the Forest Preserve District of Cook County Code of Ordinances to add a fee schedule for the new Aerial Adventure & Zipline Course.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Forest Preserve District of Cook County Board of Commissioners, that Title 7 - Fees, Chapter 1 - Fee Schedule of the Forest Preserve District of Cook County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as Follows:

7-1-1: FEE SCHEDULE

AERIAL ADVENTURE COURSE AND ZIPLINE FEES

Tree Top Adventure Course: \$57.00 (Adult Ages 16+) and \$37.00 (Child Ages 10-15)

Tree Top Junior Course: \$27.00 (All Ages)

Stand Alone Zipline: \$12.00 (All Ages)

- *Nonprofit organizations with proper documentation may qualify for a reduced rate of 30% on designated charges.
- *A reduction of 30% applies toward the last two weeks of April and for the first two weeks of November.
