


Capital Budget Overview - 2016

- \$30.6 M projected new capital spending
- \$10.5 M Grants, private investment & real estate funds
- \$ 2.8 M Remaining bond funds
- \$ 5.9 M Remaining C&D funds
- \$ 3.9 M
 New 2016 C&D (tax levy) funds
- \$ 7.5 M Transfer (\$5.5M for restoration)








