
Area of Impact Location Map, Dimensions, & Conditions




Area of Impact Location Map



Tree Assessment



A tree assessment was conducted by Village Arborist Dave Hoffman in April 2022 for the eastern 150 feet of the subject property. **None of the surveyed trees inventoried below will be removed as part of the proposed project.**

Other trees found in the area were dead, dying, broken, leaning, or Buckthorn. Tree #7 is a large Oak with a heavy lean toward the power lines along Lehigh Avenue. It has been excessively trimmed over the years by ComEd.
