The policy requires an annual report to the Board of Commissioners on discounts and waivers for the sake of transparency. The Fee Waiver and Discount Report describes specific discount categories and various passes issued pursuant to Forest Preserves Board Approved Resolution, 16-0314, dated July 12, 2016. For FY 2019, the Forest Preserves, with the cooperation of our partners, issued fee waivers to forty-seven (47) customers with a value of \$26,813.20. In addition, 2,075 passes were issued with an estimated value of \$53,904.65.
