Title: PROPOSED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

Department: Finance and Administration

Other Part(ies): Cook County Government, Chicago, Illinois

Request: Authorization to amend the intergovernmental agreement between the County of Cook (the "County") and the Forest Preserves of Cook County (the "Forest Preserves") for the reimbursement or payment for certain services rendered by various County departments and the Forest Preserves.

Goods or Services: The County and the Forest Preserves wish to extend the agreement for an additional two (2) years and to restate/amend the Agreement to provide for the transfer of certain goods and to increase the amount of reimbursement or payment between the Forest Preserves and the County for various services rendered.

Agreement Number: N/A

Agreement Period: 1/1/2019, retroactively, to 12/31/2020

Fiscal Impact: FY 2019 \$2,040,465.00 in expenditures and \$860,000.00 in revenue, FY 2020 \$2,057,483.00 in expenditures and \$860,000.00 in revenue

Accounts: Various districtwide corporate accounts

District(s): Districtwide

Summary: The County and the Forest Preserves entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement on 8/21/2012 authorizing the parties to perform various services for the other, in accordance with the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act. The parties agreed to provide various services and to provide reimbursement or payment for said services. The Intergovernmental Agreement was further amended on 4/25/2013, 6/18/2014, 9/8/2015, 11/15/2016, 6/6/2017, 4/25/2018, and 9/26/2018 to allow for additional cooperation. The Seventh Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement consolidates the prior agreements into one (1) Intergovernmental Agreement, so the parties can refer to one agreement, and allows for the transfer of certain County vehicles to the Forest Preserves. This is a two-year agreement covering fiscal years 2019 and 2020.
