b. Is sworn under oath, under penalties of perjury;

c. Is notarized;

d. c. Attests that the candidate fulfills the requirements set forth under the requisite statute, ordinance, law or regulation that creates the appointment;

e. d. Attests that the candidate possesses the adequate qualifications and skills.
