Conservation Corps programs are part of the Next Century Conservation Plan and the Expansion Strategy for the Conservation Corps, which defines conservation corps as paid employment that mobilizes people who reflect the diversity of Cook County to maintain and restore the land to ecological health. The Calumet Conservation Corps Crew engages a Crew Manager, an Assistant Crew Manager, and up to four (4) adult participants in hands-on ecological restoration activities centered on invasive species control and restoration of native plants. Participants receive training in herbicide application, prescribed fire, and chainsaw operation, in addition to experience leading various community engagement and volunteer workday events promoting forest preserve awareness. The Calumet Conservation Corps is administered by Friends of the Forest Preserves through an agreement that was originally approved by the Forest Preserves of Cook County Board of Commissioners on 11/17/2020 (Board Item No. 20-0411), and subsequently amended on 4/5/2022 (Board Item No. 22-0207) to add funding authority. Conservation Corps programs provide youth and adult participants with paid environmental education and job skills training within the conservation field, with a focus on ecological restoration in the Forest Preserves.
