HONORING THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF CHIEF CONSTRUCTION ENGINEER ADNAN NAMMARI

WHEREAS, Adnan Nammari will retire from public service to the Forest Preserves on December 29th, 2023, after a 43-year career in public-sector and private-sector engineering posts; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Nammari started work as a senior civil engineer for the Forest Preserves 28 years ago in December 1995, after graduating from the Illinois Institute of Technology with bachelor's and master's degrees in civil engineering and after serving for 15 years in private-sector engineering consultant positions; and

WHEREAS, for the past 20 years, Mr. Nammari served as Chief Construction Engineer, succeeding Paul Pearson, Harry Barrett and others, in this prestigious Forest Preserve position; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure as Chief Construction Engineer, Mr. Nammari managed the Civil Engineering section of the Department of Planning & Development and introduced new technology-based systems and tools for performing engineering design and administration of capital funds, in addition to maintaining standards and procedures for Forest Preserve construction contracts; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Nammari also oversaw many significant Forest Preserve construction programs and challenging construction contracts for new or improved bridges, dams, parking lots, picnic shelters, canoe and kayak launches and other outdoor recreation amenities; and

WHEREAS, notable outdoor recreation projects managed by Nammari included expansion of the fitness stairs at Swallow Cliff, a new nature play area and fitness stairs at Dan Ryan Woods, new picnic and program shelter prototypes, new accessible canoe and kayak facilities, and repairs to many bridges and dams at fishing lakes throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Nammari was responsible for oversight of the \$25 million Motor Fuel Tax agreement with Cook County DOTD which has resulted in transportation-related infrastructure improvements to numerous trails, bridges, access roads and adjacent parking areas; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Nammari was responsible for regular inspections and improvements to dams and other drainage and water-control structures and oversight of water and stormwater infrastructure projects on Forest Preserve land; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Nammari is a devoted husband and father of three adult children, enjoys traveling to visit family in the U.S. and Middle East, and spending time outdoors walking and biking in the Forest Preserves and along Chicago's lakefront.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that President Toni Preckwinkle along with the Forest Preserves of Cook County Board of Commissioners, General Superintendent Arnold L. Randall, and on behalf of all citizens of Cook County, do hereby extend thanks to Adnan Nammari for his dedication, leadership and outstanding service and wish him continued success in all his future endeavors; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a suitable copy of this resolution be tendered to Adnan Nammari in recognition of his significant contributions to the Forest Preserves of Cook County...end
